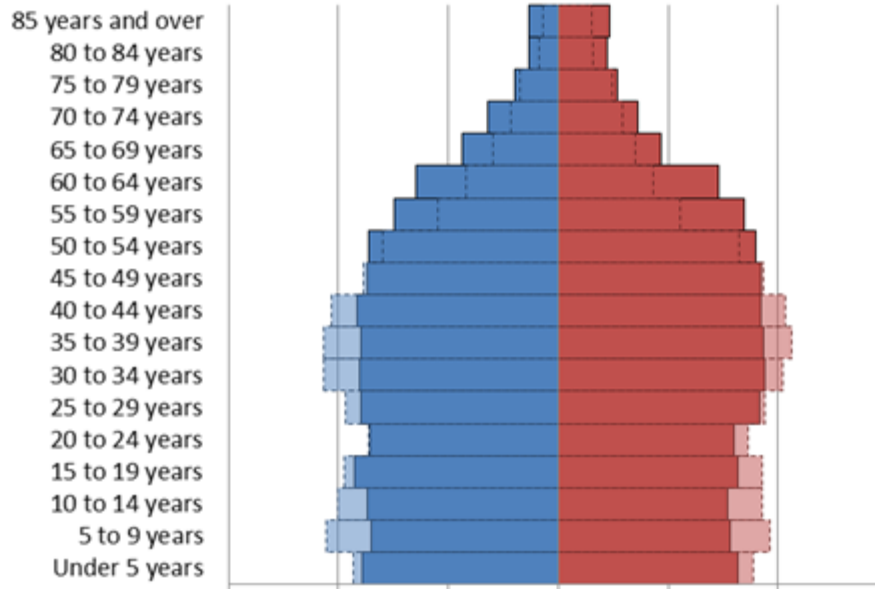

Age Distribution (NOTE TO ROBERTO – KEEP WITH POPULATION PYRAMID BELOW)

Union City’s population is aging, according to the results of the 2010 Census. The population pyramid below shows the change in the female and male population in five-year age groups from 2000 to 2010. As shown, the percentage of total population for all age brackets 49 years of age and under decreased, while the percentage of total population for those 50 years and above increased. This shift is likely the combined result of the baby boomer population aging, couples waiting longer to have children, fewer children per household, migration, and increased life expectancy.
