



## **AFTERNOONS WITH CLUB ONE**

**OUR MISSION IS TO PROVIDE A SAFE AND COMFORTABLE PLACE WHERE MIDDLE SCHOOL STUDENTS CAN BE THEMSELVES, HAVE FUN AND LEARN A LITTLE ABOUT THE WORLD AROUND THEM.**

**Who we are:** Afternoons with Club One is a before and after-school program sponsored by Union City Leisure Services. It is offered at both middle schools in Union City (Alvarado and Cesar Chavez Middle Schools). We offer a number of different activities for the students, such as tutoring, cooking, sports, crafts, tournaments, and enrichment classes.

### **How it works:**

**Block 1 (2:45 pm- 3:30 pm)** The Club One staff greets and checks in students after dismissal. During this time, students can unwind with different recreational activities that are offered and focus on homework. Students can also bring or purchase snacks. When homework is finished, students can socialize with friends and participate in some of the planned daily activities, such as basketball, playing games, and craft projects.

**Block 2 (3:30 pm – 6 pm)** From 3:30 – 4:30 pm, Club One offers various enrichment classes that broaden and challenge student's minds and interests. Different types of enrichment classes are offered each day of the week, and new classes are introduced each month. Class topics have included Guitar 101, Polynesian Dance, Candle Making, Drama, Inter-mural Sports Leagues, Conversational Spanish, Iron Chef Cooking, Movie Critics, Digital Photography, as well as subject specific tutoring. After 4:30 pm, when the enrichment classes are completed, students can continue with their homework or participate in small group games and activities until parents pick up their child.

**Before School Care (6:45 am – 8:15 am)** Club One offers "Morning Mayhem" which is early morning supervision before school. Parents can be assured that their child is safely supervised until school hours begin. The middle school policy does not allow students to be on campus before 8:10 am. Students are allowed to leave for class at 8:15 am.

**Fees:** The school year is broken into 3 sessions (each approximately 2 ½ months). Fees have been adjusted for minimum days, holidays and no school days. For each session, parents can choose to register for the full week or just specific days (i.e. Monday, Wednesday & Friday), and choose whether the student needs supervision until 4:30 pm or 6 pm. Registered Club One students may also attend program on minimum days with no additional charge. Club One closes at 6 pm sharp. Don't be late; there is a \$1 a minute late charge. Limited partial scholarships may be available.

**Minimum Days:** Afternoons with Club One offers additional activities during minimum days. Special events and activities or local field trips are planned in advance. For registered Club One participants, there is no additional charge for supervision on minimum days if it is a day they normally attend. If the minimum day is on a day the student is not currently registered or if student does not normally attend the Club One program, they can still participate by paying \$15 for a drop-in fee for supervision from dismissal until 6 pm.

**When and where to register:** Registration forms and information are available at the Holly and Kennedy Community Centers, or the Union City Sports Center.
