MEDIA RELEASE

1 The Union City Police Department is currently investigating the report of several students that may have
2 become ill after ingesting contaminated Brownies at Logan High School in Union City, CA.

4 Last week several students received emergency medical attention on the Logan High School campus.
5 During those medical treatments there was no indication from the affected students that they had
6 ingested any type of controlled substance. Unverified information began to surface among the 4200
7 students that an unidentified person or persons were providing or selling marijuana-laced brownies to
8 students. Rumors among students and staff also suggested that the brownies may have been laced with a
9 heroin-type narcotic substance. Additionally, one student at Cesar Chavez Middle School as well as one
10 student at Conley-Caraballo High School may have also ingested contaminated brownies.

12 UCPD investigators are conducting follow-up interviews to determine the validity of the information
13 and the tips being provided by parents, students, and district staff persons. The New Haven Unified
14 School District sent out an informational text and phone message on Friday evening to advise parents of
15 the situation. Although it is early in the investigation, at this point there is no verifiable evidence to
16 substantiate the fact that anyone intentionally sold or provided controlled substances on campus.
